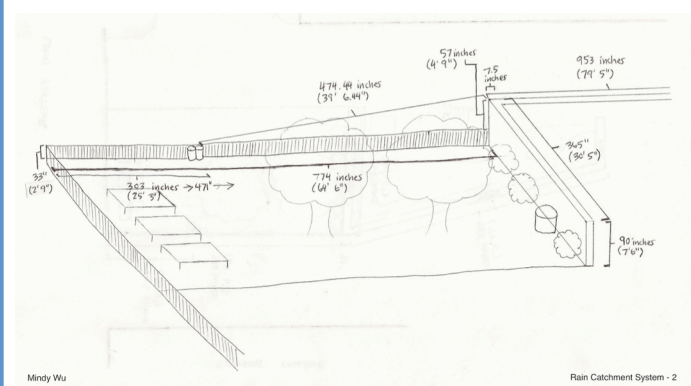


Rain Catchment System

- This will not only help the school conserve water and save money, but it will promote the garden's sustainability goal.



- Students came up with the idea when Massachusetts experienced a minor drought this summer 2012.
- The drought left plants vulnerable to pests, which was a problem for garden interns.

- After presenting plans of the rain catchment system to the headmaster, students got approval to build.
- The system is projected to be done by around spring 2012 and will pay for itself well.
